Candidates must hold a PhD in Law or Economics, with a specialisation in Law and Economics. The rank of appointment will depend on the candidate's experience and accomplishments. We seek applicants with a strong research and teaching background at the interface between Law and Economics.

Preference will be given to a candidate to a full professorship (7h/week during term-time) and ready to play an active and leading part in the development of the new joint master in Law and Economics set up by the Faculty of Law and the Faculty of Economics (HEC-Lausanne).

The successful candidate is expected to teach Advanced Law and Economics, Law and Economics of Regulation and a seminar in Law and Economics

Teaching could be conducted either in French or English.
