Call for applications for a tenure-track position (Open Rank)

The Faculty of Law at the University of Haifa seeks to fill one or more tenure-track positions, starting in **October 2025 or later**. This search is open to all sub-fields of law. Junior and senior scholars are encouraged to apply.

The faculty seeks scholars with demonstrated research excellence, an international profile, and commitment to teaching and to academic leadership, for an appointment as Assistant/Associate or Full Professor. Absent exceptional circumstances, a LL.B. or J.D., as well as a J.S.D. / S.J.D. / Ph.D. degree are required. Candidates are expected to demonstrate an outstanding academic record, as well as demonstrate the potential to contribute to one of Israel's top law schools. The faculty also encourages those candidates with a record of interdisciplinary research and knowledge of diverse cutting-edge research methods to apply.

The successful applicant will be expected to establish a highly productive research agenda, engage in the faculty's rich curricula for both LL.B. and LL.M degrees, supervise doctoral students, and take an active role in the faculty's renowned research centers. Command of Hebrew, if does not exist, will need to be acquired within a few years of arrival.
